## 1. How to Enter the Contest:

The "CU1 Skagway Member Appreciation Day" contest will begin on Thursday, April 16, 2026 at 5:30pm and end on Thursday, April 16, 2026 at 7:30pm.

- a. To participate in the contest, an individual must attend the Member Appreciation event at 306 B 3rd Ave, Skagway, AK 99840, on Thursday, April 16. Upon check-in, each attendee will receive one (1) numbered ticket for a chance to be selected. No purchase or donation is necessary. Each participant is limited to one (1) entry.
- b. At the time of the contest, a Credit Union 1 (CU1) employee will randomly select five (5) tickets from the container to determine the official contest participants. Entrants may be disqualified at the sole discretion of Credit Union 1.

## 2. Eligibility Restrictions:

- a. The contest is open to all contest participants who are 19 years of age or older and who reside in Skagway, AK, and surrounding communities. Employees, officers, and directors of Credit Union 1, their respective affiliated companies, subsidiaries, distributors, dealers, retailers, printers, advertising, and contest agencies, all other companies associated with this contest, and the members of the immediate families or households of any of the above are not eligible. Immediate family shall include spouse, parents, children, siblings, grandparents, grandchildren, and any other person residing within the same household.

## 3. Prizes:

- a. **Guaranteed Contestant Prize:** Each of the five (5) randomly selected contestants will receive a \$100 cash prize immediately upon selection.
- b. **Bonus Dice Roll Prize:** Each contestant will roll four (4) oversized dice, one at a time. For each die that lands with the CU1 logo face up, the contestant will receive an additional \$100 in cash.
- c. The maximum total prize per contestant is \$500 (\$100 for being selected + up to \$400 based on dice roll results).
- d. All cash prizes will be distributed to participants on the day of the event. Winners must be present to receive their prize.

- e. Contest prizes are not transferable. Prizes may not be substituted for or redeemed for other compensation.

4. Selection and Notification of Winners:

- a. Decisions of management with respect to the contest are final.
- b. A total of five (5) contestants will be randomly selected from all eligible entries. Contestants must be present at the time of selection to participate. If a selected contestant is not present, does not meet eligibility requirements, or declines to participate, an alternate finalist will be drawn.
- c. The first (5) eligible contestants will be given the opportunity to attempt to win a Bonus Dice Roll Prize by providing all requested information in the official registration binder and rolling a set of (4) pre-printed dice after receiving instructions to do so from the Contest Administrator. In order to be a valid attempt, each eligible contestant must:
  - i. Print and sign their full name in the official registration binder on the next unoccupied line. Name must be printed clearly to be eligible.
  - ii. After completing this information, and upon direction of the Credit Union 1, the contestant must then roll the provided set of (4) dice in accordance with the requirements outlined herein.
  - iii. Limit one (1) entry per person.
- d. For a Bonus Dice Roll Prize to be awarded, the (4) dice rolled by the contestant must come to rest a minimum of six (6) feet away with "CU1" face up in accordance with these rules.
- e. Contestants are not permitted to take any practice or warm-up rolls prior to their attempt. Once any one die has been rolled, their attempt is considered to be started.
- f. Each eligible contestant must roll/throw each oversized die one (1) at a time. Contestants may not attempt to change the outcome of any rolled die by hitting the die with a subsequent roll attempt.
- g. Each die must be tossed in a way that does not allow the contestant to "set" the dice, alter or influence the random outcome of the roll.
- h. Each die must be rolled a minimum of six (6) feet in distance from the contestant, in order to prevent the contestant from altering, affecting, influencing, or enhancing the random outcome of any roll. The contest Administrator will designate the demarcation line that each die must cross during the roll attempt, as well as the line behind which the contestant must be positioned to take his/her attempt.
- i. Each dice must make a minimum of two (2) complete rotations while in the air.

- j. All dice must come to rest lying individually and completely flat.
- k. All dice must land on and remain on the designated dice rolling surface.
- l. The following will result in the contestants being required to re-roll their entire dice roll attempt:
  - i. If any of the following outcomes occur, that dice roll attempt is disqualified and the contestant will be granted a maximum of one re-roll attempt (the contestant must re-roll that die only):
    - 1. If the contest administrator deems that any die has failed to cross the dice roll demarcation line.
    - 2. If any die is leaning in any manner.
    - 3. If any die leaves the designated dice roll playing surface.
    - 4. If any contestant inadvertently drops a die as they are preparing to roll, and the dropped die does not meet the eligible dice roll requirements as stated in the contest rules.
  - m. The odds of being selected as an official contestant(s) are dependent upon the number of entries received. The odds of a contestant winning the maximum prize of \$500 are: 1:1,296.

5. Conditions:

- a. By participating in the contest, the winner or winner (and their guest or traveling companion, if any) agree to have their name, voice, or likeness used in any advertising or broadcasting material relating to this contest without additional financial or other compensation, and to sign a publicity release prior to acceptance of the prize.
- b. Credit Union 1 reserves the right in its sole discretion to modify the contest rules and dates at any time for any reason. By participating in this contest, you agree to be bound by these contest rules, any modifications thereof, and by all other rules imposed by Credit Union 1.
- c. No purchase is necessary. Purchase does not increase chances of winning. The contest is void where prohibited.
- d. Failure to comply with the contest rules may result in a contestant's disqualification, at the sole discretion of Credit Union 1.
- e. Credit Union 1 is not responsible for typographical or other errors in the printing, the offering or the administration of the contest or in the announcement of a prize.
